8. **Ordinance No. 70-02 - Third Reading - Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to accept a 10.100 acre tract of land, more or less, on the south side of Applegrove St. N.W. from the North Canton Rotary.

9. **Ordinance No. 71-02 - First Reading - Comm. & Econ. Dev.  
Tabled: 7/8/02**

An ordinance authorizing the Administration of the City of North Canton to waive the rental fee for Dogwood Park Shelter one day a month for the months of July through December, 2002, for use by the North Canton Urban Forestry Community Awareness Initiative for a series of workshops available to the residents of the City of North Canton and declaring the same to be an emergency.

10. **Ordinance No. 79-02 - Second Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service agreement for the design of the expansion phase of the Water Treatment Plant, at a cost not to exceed \$359,500.00, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

11. **Ordinance No. 86-02 - First Reading - Comm. & Econ. Dev.**

An ordinance establishing the zoning classifications of One-Family Residential, R-70, Two-Family Residential, R-2F and General Business-B, GB-B, as specified by Ordinance No. 2940, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, for the premises known as the Oakshire Place #4 Annexation, containing 46.822 acres of land, more or less, annexed by Ordinance No. 46-02.

**12. Ordinance No. 87-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

Ordinance No. 87-02 amending Section 2. of Ordinance No. 63-02 by an increase of fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) dollars for the Viking Street Sanitary Sewer Replacement project and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**13. Ordinance No. 88-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the extension of an eight (8") inch waterline for a distance of approximately 2,196 feet to Frazer Court, situated in the Township of Plain, County of Stark, State of Ohio and known as being part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16 and part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 11 (Plain), Range 8, containing 16.5243 acres, more or less, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**16. Ordinance No. 91-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement by and between the City of North Canton, the Stark County Regional Planning Commission and 15 political subdivisions in Stark County for the preparation of the EPA NPDES Phase II Permit and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**17. Ordinance No. 92-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and the Mayor, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the metallization and painting the inside and outside of the Wash Water Tower at the Water Treatment Plant and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**18. Ordinance No. 93-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to apply for, accept, and enter into a loan agreement through the Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) in the Ohio Drinking Water Assistance Fund on behalf of the City of North Canton for planning, design and/or construction of drinking water facilities; and designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**19. Ordinance No. 94-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**

Ordinance No. 94-02 amending Appendix "A" of Ordinance No. 145-01, Appropriation Ordinance of the City of North Canton, to provide for the purchase of one (1) Pearpoint Mainline Pipeline Television Equipment for use by the Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Departments and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**20. Ordinance No. 95-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**
