8. **Ordinance No. 127-01 - Third Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish  
TABLED: 11/26/01**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement by and between the City of North Canton, Ohio, ("City") and the Township of Plain, Ohio, ("Plain Township") to provide for the installation of a waterline from Cleveland Avenue to Lydford Street and declaring the same to be an emergency.

9. **Ordinance No. 128-01 - Third Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish  
TABLED: 11/26/01**

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration for the Whitewood Street Waterline Extension Project and declaring the same to be an emergency.

10. **Ordinance No. 134-01 - Second Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the extension of an eight (8") inch waterline for a distance of approximately 2,257 linear feet to Saint James Place No. 7, located in part of the N.E., N.W., S.E. and S.W. Quarters of Section 32, Township 12 (Lake Township), Range 8 of the Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer.

11. **Ordinance No. 141-01 - First Reading - Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the transfer of funds of the City of North Canton, Ohio, from the General Fund to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2001 and declaring the same to be an emergency.

12. **Ordinance No. 142-01 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service agreement for Phase II of the Source Control Interim Action (SCIA) program for the Dressler Road Well Field, at a cost not to exceed \$252,500.00 and declaring the same to be an emergency.

13. **Ordinance No. 143-01 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, to enter into an Agreement by and between the City of North Canton and the County of Stark, by its Board of County Commissioners, to provide a credit to North Canton for use of its sanitary sewer lines for flow generated by County Customers and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**14. Ordinance No. 144-01 - First Reading - Personnel & Safety**

Ordinance No. 144-01, amending Ordinance No. 45-99, as amended, to provide an increase in the hourly rate of pay for safety forces classifications and to provide for an increase in the uniform allowance for Dispatcher C and Special Patrolman positions, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
