## Election of Officers of Council

(1) If Council wishes to proceed with secret balloting without nominations, there should be a motion and second that there will be no nominations and proceed directly with a secret ballot. Roll call vote.

(A) Requirement: Four affirmative votes of Council are needed to be elected to position of President of Council and Vice President of Council.

1. If no candidate receives four votes on the first ballot, then the individual receiving the most number of votes will be taken off the ballot and the name set aside.
2. A second ballot will be taken and the individual receiving the most votes on the second ballot will be taken off and set aside.

**Note: On the second ballot, only those names that received votes on the first ballot shall be considered.**

3. The two candidates receiving the most votes will be involved in a run-off ballot.
