10. **Ordinance No. 13-02 - Third Reading - Ord., Rules & Claims**

Ordinance No. 13-02 amending subsection 5. Meetings and Hearings: of CHAPTER D. Zoning Board of Appeals and Interpretation, Section III. ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS, of Ordinance No. 2940, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, to change the notification requirement for a variance procedure.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service agreement for an engineering study of the four (4) storm water retention basins located at 5th Street, 7th Street, Dogwood Avenue and Woodside Avenue to determine the hydraulic adequacy of the basins including the inlet/outlet structures and the physical condition and declaring the same to be an emergency.

14. Ordinance No. 30-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish

Ordinance No. 30-02 amending Section 1.A. of Ordinance No. 5-2000 in order to provide for an increase in water rates and provide for the billing and collection of water rentals.
