## NOTICE OF HEARINGS & MEETINGS

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of North Canton on Monday, January 14, 2002 at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall to consider the following change in the notification requirement for a variance procedure:

Notice of the time and place of hearings shall be mailed by first class mail by the secretary of the Board to applicant, to all ~~abutting property owners, and to other property owners determined by the Board to be affected by the case~~ property owners within 200 feet of the property as they appear in current records of the County. Property owners shall be notified ~~in the week prior to~~ at least 7 days prior to the hearing. Notice shall also be published ~~at least 7 days in the week~~ prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.

Final action according to law, will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton, Ohio subsequent to the date of said public hearing.

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Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of North Canton on Monday, January 14, 2002 at 6:20 p.m. in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall.

The hearing is with regard to a proposed zone change for part of Out Lot 230 located on Applegrove Road N.W., and known as Great Trail Girl Scout Council property and North Canton Rotary Park, from R-70, Residential, to OB, Office Building for the 3.000 acre tract known as Great Trail Girl Scout Council property, and P&I, Park & Institutional for the 10.718 acre tract known as the North Canton Rotary Park.

The North Canton Planning Commission, at their November 7, 2001 meeting, voted unanimously to approve the recommendation for the 3.000 acre tract from R-70, Residential, to OB, Office Building and voted unanimously to deny the 10.718 acre tract from R-70 to P&I, Park & Institutional.

Final action, according to law, will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the date of said public hearing.

9. **Ordinance No. 134-01 - Third Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the extension of an eight (8") inch waterline for a distance of approximately 2,257 linear feet to Saint James Place No. 7, located in part of the N.E., N.W., S.E. and S.W. Quarters of Section 32, Township 12 (Lake Township), Range 8 of the Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer.

**10. Ordinance No. 2-02 - First Reading - Street & Alley**

Ordinance No. 2-02 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to enter into a Consent Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the purpose of designating certain streets in the City to be used as emergency detour routes and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**11. Ordinance No. 3-02 - First Reading - Street & Alley**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service agreement for the design of the Castlewood Avenue Improvement Project and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**12. Ordinance No. 4-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

Ordinance No. 4-02 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service contract for the purchase of rebuilt water meters for use by the Water Department, at a cost not to exceed \$60,000.00, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**13. Ordinance No. 5-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**

Ordinance No. 5-02 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service agreement with The J Group to provide strategic consulting services with respect to matters pertaining to economic development, utilities, special events, community programs, marketing and other areas such as state and federal grant review assistance for a one year period beginning January 1, 2002 and ending December 31, 2002 at the rate of \$4,200.00 per month and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**14. Ordinance No. 6-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of breakaway fire hydrants on an as needed basis and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**15. Ordinance No. 7-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into Supplemental Sewer Agreement between the City of North Canton and the City of Canton, said agreement supplementing and amending the March 22, 1974 agreement between North Canton and Canton for Odor and Corrosion Control/Solids Handling Improvements and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**16. Ordinance No. 8-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

Ordinance No. 8-02 authorizing the extension of a public eight (8") inch diameter sanitary sewer in Orion Road N.E. from its intersection at Beechwood St. N.E. and running approximately ninety (90') feet to a manhole, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**17. Ordinance No. 9-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement for the purchase of one (1) 2002 Chevrolet Silverado pickup truck for use by the Park Department, within the purview of the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, or in the alternative, authorizing the Board of Control, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) 2002 Chevrolet Silverado pickup truck for use by the Park Department and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**18. Ordinance No. 10-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance approving, confirming and accepting a 20 foot wide Perpetual Utility Easement, being part of Out Lot 314, from Todd E. & Melinda R. LePage and a 20 foot wide Perpetual Utility Easement, being part of Out Lot 315, from Anna S. LePage, for waterline purposes, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
