**10. Ordinance No. 32-02 - First Reading - Personnel & Safety**

Ordinance No. 32-02 amending ARTICLE 33, WAGES of Ordinance No. 72-2000, as amended, Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of North Canton and the North Canton Professional Paramedics Association (NCPA), IAFF Local 3489, by the addition to Section 1. of the classification of "Emergency Medical Technician Captain" and an hourly rate of compensation for same, and the addition of Section 4. to ARTICLE 33 WAGES, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**11. Ordinance No. 33-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property**
