NOTICE OF MEETINGS & HEARING

Mr. Rick McLaughlin, Chairman of the Water, Sewer & Rubbish Committee of North Canton City Council, has requested a meeting of said Committee Members, Council, Law Department, Mayor, Director of Administration, Director of Finance and City Engineer for **Monday, March 25, 2002 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide for an update on the contracts for the Metro Regional Transit Pipeline Occupancy Agreement, the Agreement for the Connection to City of Canton Water System and the Change Order for the Raw Water Line.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of North Canton on **Monday, March 25, 2002 at 6:45 p.m.** in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall.

A request for an amendment to the North Canton Zoning Ordinance was submitted requesting a zone change for the premises situated on the east side of North Main Street and known as part of Out Lot 198 and house number 1474. The premises is presently zoned GB-A, General Business-A district and it is requested that the premises be rezoned to GB-B, General Business-B district.

The application was amended by the North Canton Planning Commission to rezone all parcels along the east side of North Main Street between Applegrove Street and Wilbur Drive, being part of Out Lot 198 and part of Out Lot 260 and approximately 654 feet deep, that are currently zoned GB-A to GB-B.

The North Canton Planning Commission, at their February 7, 2002 meeting, by a vote of 4-yes and 0-no, has recommended that the property between Applegrove Street and Wilbur Drive be zoned GB-B, General Business-B.

Final action thereon, according to law, will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the date of said public hearing.

Ordinance No. 30-02 amending Section 1.A. of Ordinance No. 5-2000 in order to provide for an increase in water rates and provide for the billing and collection of water rentals.

An ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of \$1,250,000 notes, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying costs of improving and expanding the municipal waterworks system by constructing and installing water lines, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto, and repealing Ordinance No. 33-02, and declaring an emergency.

10. Ordinance No. 37-02 - First Reading - Street & Alley

Ordinance No. 37-02 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an Agreement by and between the City of North Canton (City) and the Board of Stark County Commissioners (County) to improve the South Main Street/Everhard Road Intersection and declaring the same to be an emergency.

Ordinance No. 38-02 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish

Ordinance No. 38-02 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a PIPELINE OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT by and between METRO REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY ("Licensor") and the CITY OF NORTH CANTON ("Licensee") for the purpose of constructing, using and maintaining a twenty-four (24) inch pipeline solely for the transmission of potable water (the "Pipeline") and declaring the same to be an emergency.

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and the Mayor to enter into a contract for Asphalt Mixes for use by the Street Department of the City of North Canton and declaring the same to be an emergency.

17. Ordinance No. 44-02 - First Reading - Finance & Property

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of Gasoline and Diesel Fuel for use by all city departments and declaring the same to be an emergency.
