8. Ordinance No. 57-06 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims

An ordinance establishing the zoning classification of GB-B, General Business B, as specified by Ordinance No. 50-03, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, for the premises known as the B.P./East Maple Annexation, containing 0.765 acres of land, more or less, annexed by Ordinance No. 203-05.

9. Ordinance No. 60-06 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading – Finance & Property

An ordinance accepting the recommendations of the City of North Canton Tax Incentive Review Council ("TIRC"), concerning the agreements grantng exemptions from property taxation, to continue the existing eight (8) Community Reinvestment Area ("CRA") agreements.

# 10. Ordinance No. 64-06 - 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading - Ordinance, Rules & Claims

An ordinance establishing a schedule of fees pursuant to Section 1171.06 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, and for permit fees, mechanical heating and cooling permit fees, plumbing permit fees and electrical permit fees pursuant to the One, Two and Three Family Dwelling and Building Code of the City of North Canton, and repealing any and all legislation inconsistent herewith.

# 11. Ordinance No. 70-06 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Water, Sewer & Rubbish

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to exercise the option to extend the existing franchise contract for a two (2) year period commencing July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2008, for the collection of residential garbage, rubbish, recyclables and yard waste in the City of North Canton.
