8. **Ordinance No. 71-01 - Second Reading - Comm. & Econ. Dev.**

An ordinance establishing the zoning classifications of One-Family Residential, R-70, and Office Building, OB, as specified by Ordinance No. 2940, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, for the premises known as the Gas Light Circle Area Annexation, containing 64.301 acres, more or less, annexed by Ordinance No. 74-2000.

9. **Ordinance No. 121-01 - Third Reading - Finance. & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement by and between the City of North Canton and the City of Canton for the purpose of providing legal representation by the City of Canton through its Law Department and Prosecutor's Office with regard to the prosecution of criminal cases and other related matters as provided for therein in the Canton Municipal Court.

10. **Ordinance No. 127-01 - Second Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

11. **Ordinance No. 128-01 - Second Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration for the Whitewood Street Waterline Extension Project and declaring the same to be an emergency.

12. **Ordinance No. 131-01 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

Ordinance No. 131-01 authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an amended agreement (change order) to include a Tomco CO<sub>2</sub> Injection System, including labor, piping, material and electrical work, four P53 PH monitors with probes and mounting hardware, one electronic CO<sub>2</sub> gas flow meter/totalizer and one CO<sub>2</sub> gas detector, at a cost not to exceed \$32,957.00, said contract authorized by Ordinance No. 10-01, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
