8. **Ordinance No. 71-01 - Third Reading - Comm. & Econ. Dev.**

An ordinance establishing the zoning classifications of One-Family Residential, R-70, and Office Building, OB, as specified by Ordinance No. 2940, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, for the premises known as the Gas Light Circle Area Annexation, containing 64.301 acres, more or less, annexed by Ordinance No. 74-2000.

9. **Ordinance No. 127-01 - Third Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement by and between the City of North Canton, Ohio, ("City") and the Township of Plain, Ohio, ("Plain Township") to provide for the installation of a waterline from Cleveland Avenue to Lydford Street and declaring the same to be an emergency.

10. **Ordinance No. 128-01 - Third Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the Board of Control of the City of North Canton, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration for the Whitewood Street Waterline Extension Project and declaring the same to be an emergency.

11. **Ordinance No. 134-01 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish**

An ordinance authorizing the extension of an eight (8") inch waterline for a distance of approximately 2,257 linear feet to Saint James Place No. 7, located in part of the N.E., N.W., S.E. and S.W. Quarters of Section 32, Township 12 (Lake Township), Range 8 of the Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer.

12. Ordinance No. 135-01 - First Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a professional service contract, for a one year period, by and between the City of North Canton and American Analytical Laboratories, Inc. to provide analysis of drinking water samples and declaring the same to be an emergency.

13. Resolution No. 136-01- First Reading - Finance & Property

Resolution accepting the Amount and Rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor.

14. Ordinance No. 137-01 - First Reading - Finance & Property

Ordinance No. 137-01 authorizing the Director of Administration to waive fifty (50%) percent of the building permit fee, less the \$500.00 cost to the City for plan review, fifty (50%) percent of the plumbing permit fee, fifty (50%) percent of the electric permit fee and fifty (50%) percent of the HVAC permit fee for the parcel located on the south side of Applegrove Street NW and known as 1010 Applegrove Street NW (Great Trail Girl Scout Council) and declaring the same to be an emergency.
