**9. Ordinance No. 123-06 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims**

Ordinance No. 123-06 amending Chapter 311, Street Obstructions and Special Uses, by the addition of Section 311.04 SNOW REMOVAL of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, regarding the procedure for removing ice and/or snow, and repealing any and all legislation inconsistent herewith, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**10. Ordinance No. 126-06 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims**

An ordinance establishing the zoning classification of GB-B, General Business B, as specified by Ordinance No. 50-03, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, for the premises known as the Chambers/Pittsburg Annexation, containing 4.815 acres of land, more or less, annexed by Ordinance No. 73-06.

**12. Ordinance No. 129-06 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract by and between the City of North Canton and the Stark County Public Defender Commission for the purpose of providing legal counsel to indigent persons in Canton Municipal Court, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**13. Ordinance No. 130-06 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Finance & Property**

An ordinance to make temporary appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Canton, Ohio, for the period beginning January 1, 2007 and ending December 31, 2007, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**14. Ordinance No. 131-06 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Finance & Property**

An ordinance authorizing the supplemental appropriation of funds of the City of North Canton, Ohio, to be appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Fire Operating Levy Fund to the Maintenance of Equipment Account, in the aggregate amount of \$10,560.00, for the current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2006, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

**15. Ordinance No. 132-06 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Community & Economic Development**

Ordinance No. 132-06 amending Ordinance No. 145-04, as amended, Income Tax Ordinance of the City of North Canton, by the addition of SECTION 16, Article XV, Municipal Income Tax Credit Program.

**16. Ordinance No. 133-06 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Community & Economic Development**

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to apply for, accept and utilize two (2) Environmental Protection Agency Brownfields Assessment Grants for the purpose of funding community-wide assessments, one for Hazardous Substances Assessment and one for Petroleum Assessment, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 for each or \$400,000 for both, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
