9. Ordinance No. 123-06 - 3rd Reading - Ordinance, Rules & Claims

Ordinance No. 123-06 amending Chapter 311, Street Obstructions and Special Uses, by the addition of Section 311.04 SNOW REMOVAL of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, regarding the procedure for removing ice and/or snow, and repealing any and all legislation inconsistent herewith, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

10. Ordinance No. 126-06 – 2nd Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims
