A request for an amendment to the North Canton Zoning Ordinance was submitted requesting a zone change for the premises situated on the west side of Pittsburg Avenue and known as Lot No. 5019 and house number 719. The premises is presently zoned OB, Office Building district and it is requested that the premises be rezoned to R-50, Residential district.

The North Canton Planning Commission, at their September 11, 2002 meeting, by a vote of 4-yes and 0-no, has recommended that the property be rezoned from OB to R-50.

Final action thereon, according to law, will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the date of said public hearing.
