The public hearing was called to order Monday, January 9, 2006, at 6:30 p.m. by President of Council Doug Foltz.

The hearing is with regard to a request to vacate Alley No. 9 from the south end of the alley and running in a northerly direction to the southern property line of Lot 930 on the west and the southern property line of Lot 938 on the east.

The North Canton Planning Commission, at their November 9, 2005 meeting, voted to approve the partial vacation of Alley No. 9 as described above.

Final action thereon will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the public hearing.

Mr. Foltz: The next public hearing – we're running late on this one for request to vacate Alley No. 9 from the south end of the alley and running in a northerly direction to the southern property line of Lot 930 on the west and the southern property line of Lot 938 on the east. Now, there's some minutes from the Planning Commission attached. Would anybody like to address Council on this issue? No? For or against – anybody in the audience like to address Council on this issue – on this alley vacation?

Mr. Lane: It's the area behind the Harleigh Inn, if anybody wants to –

Mrs. Magel: About five (5) blocks from there. It runs parallel to Main Street.

Mr. Lane: Right behind the Harleigh Inn, basically. They had a very in-depth discussion at the Planning Commission meeting when this was discussed, and they recommended approval of it.

Mr. Foltz: Okay.

Mr. Lane: So, just to bring everybody up to date.

Mr. Foltz: Well, if not, then we'll close the public hearing.
