CALL TO ORDER:

The public hearing was called to order Monday, October 4, 2004 at 6:15 p.m. by President of Council Jon Snyder.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of North Canton on Monday, October 4, 2004 at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall. The purpose of the hearing will be to establish zoning for the recently annexed Orion Street area. The North Canton Planning Commission has recommended that the area be zoned R-70, Residential Single Family. Final action thereon, according to law, will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the date of said public hearing.
