CALL TO ORDER:

The special council meeting was called to order Monday, October 4, 2004 at 6:10 p.m. by President of Council Jon Snyder.

Mr. Snyder: May I have a motion to read by title only, first reading of Ordinance No. 132-04?

Mrs. Kiesling moved and Mr. Peters seconded to **read by title only, first reading** of Ordinance No. 132-04. All members present voting:

Mr. Snyder: You didn't have your microphone on. That was your problem. Mr. Pusateri: Oh, I see, I'm sorry. Inaudible... read this ordinance, right?

Mr. Snyder: Please.

Ordinance No. 132-04 - First Reading

Ordinance No. 132-04 amending Section 1(b) of Ordinance No. 118-93, as amended, by removing Section 1(b), which will remove subsection (b) of Section 935.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, for the purpose of eliminating the requirement for nonresidents to agree, upon request of the City of North Canton, to annex the nonresident's property to the City of North Canton, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

Mr. Snyder: Chairman Kiesling.

Mrs. Kiesling: Yes, this is the clause that we are going to remove from – when we give someone water or they tap into our water system we're not going to require them to sign an annexation agreement. We decided that it's time that we do that. And that's what it is and I'd like to pass it on an emergency.

Mr. Snyder: Is there any other comment? I think the time has passed and this ordinance has well served its purpose. In the competitive environment we're in today, both from the south and from the north, that we now begin to realize as a public water service that we're able to sell water without the codicil or without the requirement that the people annex to the City of North Canton. And I do recommend and support that. Is there any other comment from the Water Chairman?

Mr. Sarbach: Yea, I'd just like to – a lot of my feelings are based on what Mike has told me over the last several months. Looking at it from the outside and now he's on this side of it and with his legal background and his water background, I think the time has come to change this or bring it up to the times. And I think it has served us well for many years and maybe not in recent years, but I think there was a time when this was good and now it's time to move on. So I would be in favor of this motion.

Mr. Snyder: Any other comments?

Mr. Foltz: Jon, Mr. Snyder: Sir.

Mr. Foltz: Yea, I'd like – what I'd like to say is that I think it's past due too. Because I supported this a number of years ago. And basically it doesn't mean we can't work with the townships around us to bring in CEDA's or JED's or other annexations, it's just their water rates would be reduced at that point. So I think if we sell water to our neighbors, it's what we're in the business to do since we've spent a lot of money in capital improvements on our Water Treatment Plant. So I'm very much in favor for those various reasons.

Mr. Snyder: And your points are well taken. Anyone else? Does the administration ...inaudible...

Mr. Miller: Nothing to add since last week.
