Dear Mr. Osborne:

As a follow-up to your telephone call, I spoke with Hoover High School Athletic Director Joe Eaton to collect the following information:

In 1998, five tennis courts were constructed at Hoover High School which greatly reduced our need to use city-maintained tennis courts. Girls' tennis is a fall sport and practices Monday through Friday in the morning during the three weeks prior to the start of the school year in late August. Once school begins, the school tennis courts are used for matches or practice Monday through Friday from approximately 2:45 - 6:30 p.m. until the season ends in mid-October.

Boys' tennis commences with practices and matches in mid-March and concludes in early June. The courts are used with days and times similar to the girls' schedule.

Physical education classes use the school tennis courts several hours per day for 2-3 days per week for several weeks in the fall and the spring.

The public is welcome to use our tennis courts at times when they are not used for school physical education classes or by the tennis teams. Public use and school use have not seemed to create any conflicts.

I hope this information is helpful.
